Guidelines

A community leader, mentor, employer, coworker, or friend may submit an application.

All nominations are evaluated using the same scoring criteria. An independent jury comprised of community leaders involved with Peel Children's Aid Foundation will select 3 finalists.

Once the finalists are picked, the community will have the opportunity to vote for their favourite Fierce and Fabulous nominee.

The nominee with the popular vote will be presented the Fierce and Fabulous Award on Thursday, April 30, 2020 at the Mississauga Convention Centre.

What is a fierce & fabulous woman?

- Actively encourages other women to be powerful mentors and allies to other women in the workplace.
- Supports girls and women in crisis.
- Inspires children to take part in shaping the future.
- Understands the importance of social change.
- Helps a new mom.
- Invests in women entrepreneurs.

- Promotes equality, diversity, healthy equal relationships.
- Teaches children to succeed and be committed.
- Prevents violence against women and girls.
- Advocates and raise funds for children, youth, and families.

- Contributes to sustainable development, including health and the welfare of society.

- Previous award winners are not allowed to be nominated.
- One nomination per nominee is required.
- Nominees must be residents or an employee in the Region of Peel.
- Self-nominations and letters of support from family members are not accepted.

When do the nominations open?

Nominations are open from Monday, February 3, 2020 to Monday, March 2, 2020.
